**From Darrel's Desk . . .**

It was in 1977 that Bert Lance, President Jimmy Carter's Director of the Office of Management and Budget, said that he believed he could save Uncle Sam billions if he could get the government to adopt a single motto: *'If it ain't broke, don't fix it.'*



Lance's words became the motto of mediocrity and the mantra of the mindset of maintenance. People who live by that slogan never improve: they only plateau.

I.I.A.B.D.F.I. (If It Ain't Broke Don't Fix It) would never have invented heavier than air flight because, although Orville and Wilbur owned and operated a bicycle shop, the Wright Brothers weren't just trying to repair a broken bicycle when they invented the airplane: they were trying to fly!

With an I.I.A.B.D.F.I.attitude, Ted Hoff would never have invented the microprocessor, which is integral to personal computers. With an I.I.A.B.D.F.I. attitude, Willis Haviland Carrier would never have developed the air conditioner. With an I.I.A.B.D.F.I., no one would invent anything.

I.I.A.B.D.F.I. would never have taken five talents and then returned ten. I.I.A.B.D.F.I. would never have taken two talents and then returned four. But I.I.A.B.D.F.I. would take one talent, bury it and then return it and say, "well, I took what you entrusted to me and preserved it and maintained it." (Matthew 25:14-30)

It has been said that "We've never done it that way before" are the seven last words of a dying church. Maybe. But I suspect the seven favorite words of a stagnant church are "If it ain't broke don't fix it." When the Lord returns and demands an accounting from us of what we have done with that with which he has entrusted us, I.I.A.B.D.F.I. will not receive his reward. It will receive his wrath.

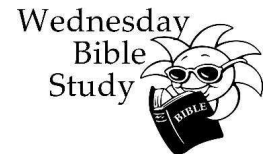
