From Darrel's Desk . . .

In Psalm 41, David wrote, "Blessed is he who has regard for the weak; the LORD delivers him in times of trouble."



Clay City Christian Church donates 25% of undesignated gifts to mission work. ("Undesignated" means money that the donor has not specified for a specific purpose.) On our website, in our annual "Communicator" and in our monthly financial report, you can find a list of the missions we support.

Among those missions, some are specifically benevolent in nature. "Blessed is he who has regard for the weak;" and who is weaker than children and the elderly? We support Pinehaven Christian Children's Ranch in Montana and the Oblong Children's Christian Home in our own state. We send occasional gifts to the Wabash Christian Retirement Village in Carmi, IL. We also help to fund the Clay City Ministerial Alliance to underwrite their work in helping both transients and residents who have short-term emergency needs. In addition to that, we provide some direct benevolent assistance.

It is not easy to know whether we help people the most by saying "yes" to their request or if we help the most by saying "no". We must decide on a case-by-case basis and we always do so with a lot of prayer. Some people have genuine and unavoidable needs while others have needs of their own creation or are simply looking for a way to avoid working for a living but it is not always easy to tell the difference.

In all cases, our benevolent ministry is intended to be an expression of what David wrote in Psalm 41:1. It is a blessing to help those who are truly weak and it is a responsibility to help them get strong enough to stand on their own. Please pray for us as we try to be good stewards of God's resources.
