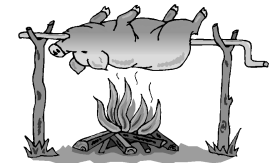

Hasbro, Inc. is introducing a version of the venerable board game that substitutes a Visa-imprinted debit card for the stacks of yellow, blue and purple play money with which we are all familiar. The television ad promises that this change will speed up the playing of the game.

For crying out loud, are we in that much of a hurry? Seventy-one years ago, when Monopoly was created, it was supposed to give families a chance to spend time together. But now we have to hurry up and finish the game.

Originally, Monopoly was supposed to give depression-weary people an escape from their joyless reality and a chance to own what in real life they could never afford. But now we have to go in debt in fantasy just as in reality.

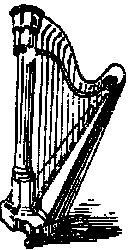
